# Free School Meals

To claim Free School Meals you need to receive Child Benefit and either:

- Income Support
- Job Seekers Allowance – Income Based
- Employment and Support Allowance - Income Related
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Pension Credit Guarantee
- Child Tax Credit (with **no Working Tax Credit**) and an annual gross income of £16,190 or less
- You CANNOT claim Free School Meals if: -
  - You or your partner jointly work 24 hours or more a week, with one of you working at least 16 hours or more OR
  - You are a single parent and you work 16 hours or more each week

## Cashless system.

The system works exactly the same for all pupils whether they pay or have a free school meal. The amount allocated for the free school meal will be entered into the system by the software daily and will only be accessible at lunch time. The system will then allow on a daily basis the required cash amount for each individual pupil to be allocated to their current cash balance.

The pupil can also add extra cash onto his or her balance in the system by using the revaluation station, to enable a greater daily spend on the school dinner than allocated by their free meal allowance. As the Free School Meal allowance can only be spent on a school dinner, extra cash added into the system can also be used for break time snacks.

**There will be no more queuing to be issued a free school meal ticket.**
